Everyday Math Update

We are wrapping up Unit 1 and will be having a test on Tuesday, October 2, 2012. Notes were taken in class and we will be reviewing until the day of the test. Here are some of the key concepts on the assessment:

- Naming polygons using clues
- Be able to draw parallel lines, intersecting lines, perpendicular lines, line segments, rays, and lines.
- Be able to name lines, rays, and line segments.
- Know the difference between concave and convex.
- Be able to identify and draw concentric circles.
- Identify and draw congruent shapes.
